We published monthly eNewsletters and hosted virtual meetings each quarter with our members and guests to disseminate information about emerging issues in the field and to build partnerships. We also hosted an in-person meeting focused on innovations in the tax system.

Our updated mission is "The Tax Equity Funders Network brings together national, regional and local level funders working to improve equity and economic security by reducing the tax burden on lower-income workers and modernizing state and federal tax systems."

We will continue to support and advocate for equity in the tax code through tax credits for low and moderate-income individuals and families as well as tax systems that increase access and reduce barriers for the most vulnerable and marginalized members of our society.
